

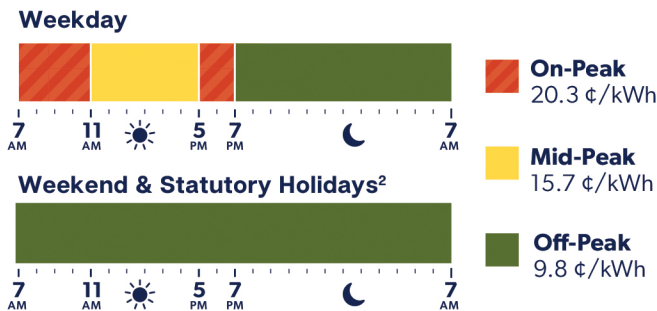

New Time-of-Use, Tiered and Ultra-Low Overnight Prices

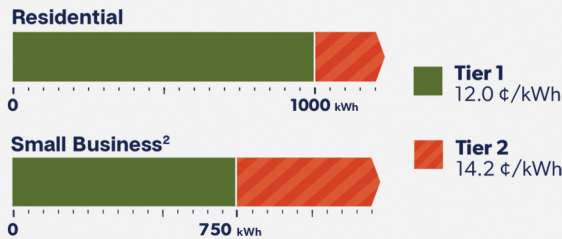

With Tiered prices, you can use a certain amount of electricity each month at a lower price. Once you exceed that limit, a higher price applies.

Pre-Authorized & Other Payment Options

Variable Pre-Authorized withdraws the full amount of your bill from your bank account on the due date. Equal Pre-Authorized withdraws the same amount from your bank account every month on a regular recurring date (choose from 1st to the 28th). Equal Payment Plan is similar to the Equal Pre-Authorized, however, there is no requirement for automatic payment withdrawals. Visit ellexiconenergy.com for more information.



Kubra EZ-Pay Options

This program provides ongoing support through a monthly credit applied directly on qualified customers' electricity bills.

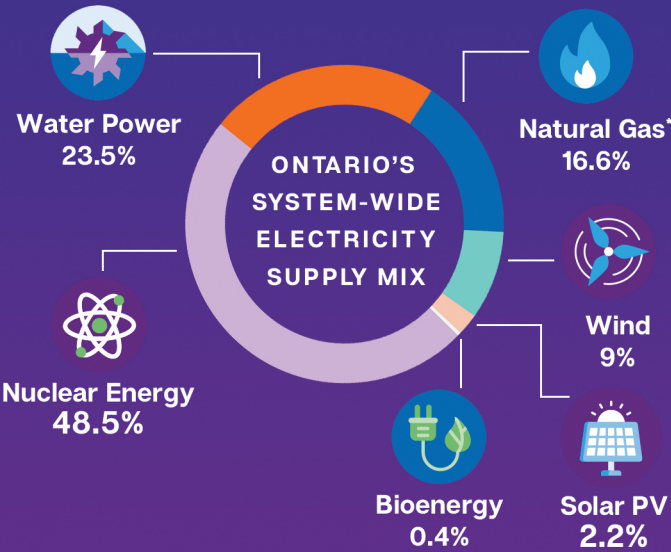

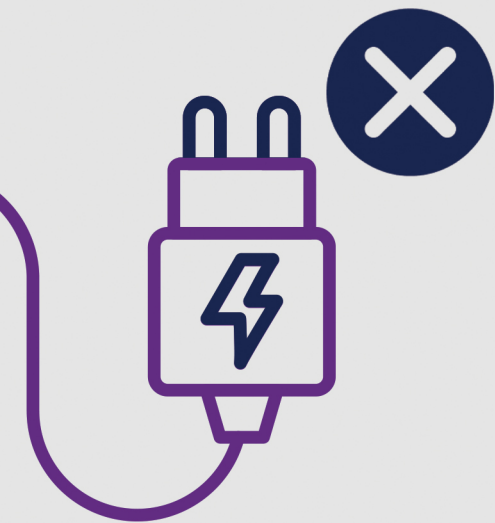


Where your electricity comes from
